RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

In view of the stand taken by the State in para 20 of the written statement, this petition can be disposed of with a direction to the competent authority in the respondent department to pass a fresh order in the light of the judgment and order dated 30.5.2013 passed in LPA No.645 of 2013; State of Haryana and others v. Sunil Kumar and others.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that in this fresh exercise a direction may also be issued that final order be passed within a time bound period.

The prayer of the petitioner is reasonable.

Consequently, a direction is issued to the competent authority in the respondent department to consider the matter in the light of the judgment passed by the Division Bench of this Court noticed above and pass a fresh order within 30 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In the meantime, order of reversion will not be given effect to till the final orders are passed.
