1. The petitioner is the land-lord. He is aggrieved because appeal preferred against order of eviction dated 21.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) has not been decided till date. The case description is Rent Appeal No. 29 of 2024 titled as 'Summat Parsad Vs. Anil Kumar'.
