The present writ petition has been filed for setting aside the show cause notice dated 29.03.2023 (Annexure P-5) issued to the petitioners for the recovery of pension amount disbursed to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in show cause notice certain recoveries have been made against the petitioners and against the said show cause notice, the petitioners have already filed reply but no order has been passed so far but in reply to the legal notice served, the claim has been rejected that is why the present writ petition has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the respondents are under obligation to pass an appropriate order on the show cause notice dated 29.03.2023, copy of which has been appended as

Annexure P-5 by considering all the pleas taken by the petitioners in reply to the said show cause notice whereas, no such order is being passed.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case appropriate order to the show cause notice (Annexure P-5) dated 29.03.2023 has not been passed so far, the same will be passed within a period of four weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner that in case the petitioner is aggrieved against the order to be passed now, he can avail appropriate remedy.

Ordered accordingly.
