This is a writ petition preferred by the petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the assured and sanctioned capital subsidy along with interest as per the policy decision and the order passed by the High Court in CWP No. 19007 of 2002, decided on May 20, 2011 which was upheld by LPA Bench on August 12, 2013.

The reason for denial of the relief claimed is not before this Court but counsel for the petitioner submits that a detailed representation for seeking the relief has been submitted vide annexure P-4 dated November 28, 2016. Counsel submits that he would be satisfied at this stage in case

In the interest of justice, this petition can be disposed of in limine.

This petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction that respondent No.2 i.e. Director of Industries and Commerce would consider the claim of the petitioner by passing a speaking order taking into consideration all the pleas taken up in representation annexure P-4. In case any representation is not traceable in the office, annexure P-4 appended with the petition may be considered as representation. It is directed that the said representation will be decided within a period of three months after the receipt of certified copy of the order, by the above said authority, by passing a speaking order.
