## **HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)**

- 1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus*, directing respondents No.1 to 3 to decide the representations dated 25.01.2023, 23.10.2023 and 11.03.2024 (Annexures P-8 to P-10) submitted by petitioner and to make necessary changes in the revenue records as well as Gardawari/Jamabandi-Fard, in view of Civil Court judgments and decrees.
- 2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail her other remedies available under the law.
