- 1. The present is a restoration application against the order dated 25.07.2017 whereby the appeal was dismissed in non-compliance of the per emptory order dated 25.03.2017 passed by the Court. Vide order dated 25.03.2017, three weeks' time was granted to remove the defects as pointed out by the office which were not removed within the stipulated period.
