**Order**

The present bail application has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. The petitioner has been arrested in connection with FIR No.292/2021 registered at Police Station Jawaja, District Ajmer for the offence(s) under Section 54A of Rajasthan Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been wrongly implicated in this case. He is behind the bars since 17.6.2022. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that illicit liquor was recovered from possession of co-accused Prabhu Lal and Bhanwar Lal and they were enlarged on bail by Co-ordinate Bench of this court. Petitioner was made an accused on account of registered owner of the vehicle. Conclusion of trial may take long time. Hence, the petitioner be enlarged on bail.

Learned GA Cum AAG has opposed the bail application.

Considering the contentions put-forth by the counsel for the petitioner and taking into account the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this court deems it just and proper to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Balindra Singh S/o Shri Naphe Singh** shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
