- The present bail application has been filed under 1. Section 438 Cr.P.C. in connection with FIR No.344/2017 registered at Police Station Christianganj, District Ajmer for the offence(s) under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC.
- Learned counsel for the accused-applicant has stated 2. at Bar that in compliance of order dated 21.09.2022, the applicant has joined the investigation. The matter pertains to the year 2013. However, learned counsel for the accused-applicant has submitted that the accused-applicant had resigned from the company prior to the registration of the complainant in the instant matter.
- Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the 3. bail application.
- Considering the contentions put-forth by the counsel 4. for the parties and looking to the overall facts and circumstances of

the case and material on record but without commenting up on the merits of the case, this court deems it just and proper to allow the anticipatory bail application.

- Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application is allowed. 5. The S.H.O/I.O/Arresting Officer, Police Station Christianganj, District Ajmer in F.I.R. No.344/2017 is directed that in the event of arrest of the accused-applicant Uddhalak Dhar S/o Shri Adhir Chandra, he shall be released on bail, provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the Rs.25,000/- each to of the satisfaction sum of the S.H.O/I.O/Arresting Officer of the concerned Police Station on the following conditions:-
 - that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
 - (ii) that the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or any police officer, and
 - (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without previous permission of the court.
