- 1. Counsel submits that the petitioners were engaged on the Post of Computer Operator on contract basis way back in the year 2005 and their services were found to be satisfactory. Counsel submits that now the respondents are bent upon to replace their services by engaging another set of contractual employees. Counsel submits that the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court has passed an interim order in a batch of two writ petitions with the lead case of Gajendra Sikhwal vs. Rajasthan State Beverage Corporation Ltd.; S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.11951/2023 wherein an interim order has been passed restraining the respondents, not to replace the co-petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 04.07.2023. Counsel submits that since the controversy involved in all these matters is identical and similar, so the similar order be passed in the present case as well as to protect the services of the petitioner.
- 2. Issue notice of all writ petitions as well as stay applications to the respondents. Rule is made returnable by 31.08.2024.



- Till next date, the respondents are restrained to not to replace the services of the petitioners pursuant to the order dated 04.07.2023 and allow the petitioner to continue on their post if their services are found to be satisfactory.
