#### ORDER

Delay of 52 days is condoned.

Heard Mr. Vikaramjit Banerjee, learned ASG appearing for the petitioners.

The Division Bench of the High Court dismissed the Writ Petition challenging the order passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal on the ground of inordinate delay of eight months. The Court opined that the delay was not appropriately explained.
