From the material placed on record, it appears that the reserve bid value was fixed at Rs. 1,42,325/-. The petitioner offered the highest rate at Rs.1,25,500/- only, which was less than the reserve bid value. However, subsequently the petitioner alone was called for negotiation and he enhanced his offer to Rs.1,35,987/-, which was also lower than the reserve bid value.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, when the work order/tender in favour of the petitioner has been cancelled by the High Court and it was directed to invite the fresh tender, it cannot be said that the High Court has committed any error.

The Special Leave Petition stands dismissed.
