petitioners.

The present special leave petition assails the order
dated 05.01.2018 passed by the learned Single Judge of the High
Court of Calcutta in CPAN 717 of 2016 in W.P.11970(W) of 2009.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, we are
inclined to consider the impugned order as a notice to show cause,

and accordingly, request the High Court to proceed by treating it as a show cause notice. The personal presence of the alleged contemnor stands dispensed with. The High Court, after perusal of the show cause, if feels appropriate, may direct for personal presence of the alleged contemnor.

The special leave petition stands disposed of accordingly.
