He would advert to Rule 8(6) of the Uttar Pradesh Subordinate Educational (Trained Graduate Grade) Service (4<sup>th</sup>

Amendment) Rules, 2016 to point out that for the post of Assistant Teacher Hindi, what is prescribed by the Rules is a Bachelor's Degree with Hindi as a subject from a recognised University and Intermediate with Sanskrit as a subject or equivalent examination with Sanskrit. It is next submitted that the petitioners not only have graduated in Sanskrit, but also have Sanskrit as a subject in their intermediate level of education.
