Heard Mr.G.Sivabalamurugan, learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is submitted by Mr.Sivabalamurugan that no enquiry has been conducted as against the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid, we grant liberty to the petitioner to file an application for review before the High Court within four weeks hence, and request the High Court to dispose of the review on merits instead of throwing it away at the threshold on the ground of limitation. In case the petitioner does not
