- (4)The number of plots/flats that remain to be sold or

alienated with their sizes.

- (5) The status of plots that have already been sold and whether they have already been built upon by the purchasers;
- (6) The number of flats/E.W.S flats constructed by the petitioner and the extent of area covered by the same.
- (7) The total Project cost incurred by the petitioner on developing the area in-question and the amount already received towards sale price of plots and flats, already sold.
