ORDER

- 1. Leave granted.

- 5. We, accordingly, set aside the order of the High Court. The parties are at liberty to avail of such remedies as may be available to them in law in respect of any dispute pertaining to management of the society.
- 6. The appeal is disposed of accordingly.
