1. Leave granted.

2. This Appeal by way of Special Leave Petition is against the decision of National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission (the 'NCDRC') in Review Application No. 434 of 2023 in Consumer Case No. 2428 of 2017 dated 15.12.2023. The submission of the learned counsel for the appellant(s) is that the review application was taken up and decided without giving notice to the appellant(s) and an opportunity of being heard.
