UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following O R D E R $\,$

Respondent nos. 1,25,27,28 and 35 have filed counter affidavit.

Respondent nos. 2 to 4, 6 to 8, 11,12,20 to 23, 26,29,33, 36 to 38 and 40 to 48 have failed to file counter affidavit despite last opportunity having been granted, as such, further opportunity is declined. However, ld. Counsel appearing for respondent no.2 and all the State functionaries submitted that copies of pleadings have not been received. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submitted that he will be providing copies of pleadings today itself.
