- The apprehension which has been expressed by the Solicitor General of India is that since the judgment of the Division Bench of the High Court of Telangana dated 10 December 2022 was upheld in the judgment of this Court dated 27 March 2023, the judgment of this Court may be interpreted in the future to mean that the grant of a personal hearing is mandatory though it has not been so directed in the conclusions set out in paragraph 81 of the judgment.
- While upholding the judgment of the High Court of Telangana dated 10 December 2020, the operative directions of this Court are those which are summarized in paragraph 81 in section 'E' of the judgment.
- The Solicitor General states that in respect of his submission that the judgment of the Court should be granted only prospective effect, the State Bank of India may be advised to file a review separately.
