O R D E R

In the facts and circumstances of the present case, we are not inclined to interfere with the matter and even after looking at the issues from all angles, we are convinced that the end result would be the same i.e., the respondents/original applicants have made out a case for their appointment on the post in question. The other

question with regard to retrospectivity is also noted to be the principle that for no fault, the concerned rejected on respondents have suffered and their entitlement to consequential benefits from the date any person appointed on the post pursuant to the same exercise is reiterated. However, we make it clear that the observations made in paragraphs no.36 and 41 of the impugned judgment with regard to course of action to be adopted in future transactions is concerned, the same shall not be binding on the petitioners and would depend on the facts and circumstances of the case as it emerges in future.
