**OFFICE REPORT**

The matter above mentioned was listed before the Ld. Registrar Court on 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2015, when he was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Among 210 respondents vakalatnama on behalf of respondents 187, 207 and 209 is still awaited though the counter affidavit has already come on record. The same be filed within two weeks time. Counter Affidavit in respect of 4 to 6 is already on record, Service with respect to 7, 11, 147, 25, 31, 33, 35-37, 51, 59, 60, 62, 64, 66, 75, 78, 87, 91, 94, 99, 104, 106, 108, 116, 131, 134, 141, 143-146, 182, 198, 204, 209 and 210 is complete. But none has entered appearance. Petitioner still has to take fresh steps to effect service on respondents 1 to 3, 177-180, 184 to 190, 192, 192, 194 to 197, 205 and 206. Three weeks time is given and notice thereafter be issued. List on 8.7.2015”

It is submitted that there are 210 respondents in the matter. Mr. D. Mahesh Babu and Mr. V.R. Anumolu, Advocate has filed vakalatnama/appearance on behalf of respondent nos. 1 to 3 and respondent nos. 177, 178, 179, 180, 184 to 190, 192, 194 to 197, 205 and 206 and he has on 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2015 filed counter affidavit only on behalf of Respondent nos. 179, 177, 178, 180, 181, 184 to 188, 190 to 192, 194 to 197, 205 to 209 without filing vakalatnama/appearance on behalf of Respondent nos. 181, 207 to 209.

It is further submitted that counsel for the petitioner has not furnished the complete address of respondent nos. 44, 54, 57, 61, 65, 91, 96, 98, 105, 167, 168, 178, 179 and 202 so far.

It is further submitted that counsel for the petitioner has not filed copy of proof of service of complete set of pleadings to counsel for the

respondent nos. 1 to 3, 177, 178, 179, 180, 184 to 190, 192, 194 to 197, 205 and 206.

It is further submitted that Mr. V. R. Anumolu, Advocate has on 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2014 filed Vakalatnama/Appearance on behalf of Respondent but there are two signatures in vernacular language but counsel has not mentioned name of those respondents.

It is further submitted that Mr. M.P. Shorawala, Advocate has on 24<sup>th</sup> November, 2014 filed vakalatnama/appearance on behalf of Respondents Nos. 4 to 6, 9, 10, 12 to 15, 17 to 20, 23, 24, 26, 27, 28, 30, 32, 34, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 45, 46 to 50, 55 to 58, 63, 65, 67, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, 73, 76, 77, 79, 80, 81 to 84, 86, 88, 90, 92, 95, 97, 99 to 100, 103, 110, 111, 112, 113, 114, 115, 117, 118, 121, 122, 123, 124, 126, 127, 128, 130, 132, 135, 138, 139, 140, 142, 147, 148, 149, 150, 151, 152, 155, 156, 157, 158 to 160, 164, 169, 170, 171, 172, 174, 175 and 176 and also filed counter affidavit on their behalf.

It is further submitted that service is complete through A. D. Cards on respondent Nos. 7, 11, 14, 25, 31, 33, 35 to 37, 51, 59, 60, 62, 64, 66, 75, 78, 87, 91, 94, 99, 103, 104, 106, 108, 116, 119, 131, 134, 141, 143 to 146, 182, 198, 204, 209, 210 but none has entered appearance on behalf of the said respondents.

It is further submitted that unserved covers received from Respondent Nos. 52, 72, 76, 86, 101, 120, 137, 165, 173, 193, 199, 203 and 207 with postal remarks 'unclaimed'. Hence returned to sender'. Neither AD card nor unserved cover received from remaining unserved Respondents.

It is further submitted that Mr. Vishal Arun, Advocate has on 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 filed application for impleadment as party respondent no. 211 with affidavit alongwith vakalatnama/appearance on behalf of proposed respondents and the same is registered as I.A. No. 5 and Ms. Sudha Gupta, Advocate has 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2014 filed application for Intervention as Respondents alongwith vakalatnama/appearance on behalf of proposed Respondents and the same were listed before the Hon'ble Judge-in-Chamber on 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2015, when the Hon'ble Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Four weeks' time is granted to the learned  
counsel for the other side to file reply to the IAs.”

It is submitted Hon'ble Court that no reply to the IA No. 5 and IA No. 7 has been filed.

It is submitted that Ms. Shirin Khajuria, Advocate has not withdrawn vakalatnama/appearance filed on behalf of Respondent no. 81 in view of Registrar's Court order dated 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2014. However, Mr. M.P. Shorawala, Advocate has filed vakalatnama/appearance on behalf of Respondent no. 81 without taking no objection.

Service is complete on all Respondents except respondent nos. 8, 16, 29, 44, 52 to 54, 58, 61, 74, 85, 89, 93, 96, 98, 101, 102, 105, 107, 109, 120, 125, 129, 133, 136 to 137, 154, 161 to 163, 165 to 168, 173, 181, 183, 191, 193, 199 to 203, 207 to 208.
