O R D E R

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and having perused the material on record, we are not inclined to consider interference in the discretion as exercised in this matter by the High Court while passing the interim order, directing release of the goods and vehicles on payment of 1/4th of the demanded amount and by furnishing personal bond for the remaining amount.
