Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the present case and particularly that both the petitioner as well as the complainant are married and that the allegations are with regard to a much earlier period from the date on F.I.R. is lodged, we are inclined to confirm the which interim protection granted by this Court on 01.09.2021.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Crime No. 326 of 2021 registered at Police Station Sarkanda, District Bilaspur (CG), subject to executing bail bonds for Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) with one or sureties in the like amount.
