**OFFICE REPORT**

The matters above-mentioned were listed before the Hon'ble Court on 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 with office report dated 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2016, when the Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

**“List the matters of 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2016.”**

It is submitted that counsel for the petitioner has on 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 filed written submissions in S.L.P.(C) No. 28966 of 2012. Copies of the same have been included in the paper books.

It is further submitted that counsel for the sole respondent has on 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2016 filed counter affidavit (in separate volume) in S.L.P(C) No 20442 of 2015. Paper books of the counter affidavit are being circulated herewith.

It is lastly submitted that counsel for the petitioners has on 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2016 and 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2016 filed applications for stay in S.L.P.(C) Nos. 20109, 20630, 23301, 23394, 23295, 23297 and 23299 of 2015.

The said applications have been registered as Interlocutory Application Nos. 1, 2 and 3 respectively. Paper books of the said applications are being circulated herewith.

SLP(C) NO. 1907 OF 2016

The matter above mentioned was listed before the Hon'ble Court on 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2016, when the Hon'ble Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

**“Delay condoned.**

**Issue notice returnable within eight weeks.**

**The operation of the impugned order shall be stayed subject to release of 50% amount due to the respondent in terms of the impugned order.**

**Tag the SLP © Nos. 28194-201 of 2010.”**

It is submitted that there are four respondents. Mr. Shardul S. Shroff, Advocate has filed Caveat/Vakalatnama/Appearance on behalf of respondent No. 2 but has not filed counter affidavit so far. Show cause notice was issued to Respondent Nos. 1, 3 and 4 through registered A.D. Post on 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2016. Mr. Gopal Singh Advocate has on 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2016 filed Vakalatnama/Appearance on behalf of Respondent Nos. 3 and 4 but he has not filed Counter Affidavit on their behalf so far. A.D. Card duly signed has been received back from Respondent No. 1 but no one has filed Vakalatnama/Appearance on behalf of the said Respondent so far.

SLP(C) NO. 18447 OF 2015

The matter above-mentioned was listed before the Hon'ble Court on 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 when the Hon'ble Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

**“Permission to file special leave petition is granted.**

**Delay condoned.**

**Notice.”**

Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to all the six respondents on 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2015 through registered A.D. Post. Ms. Hemantika Wahi, Advocate has on 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2015 filed Vakalatnama/Appearance on behalf of Respondent No.4 but she has not filed Counter Affidavit on behalf of Respondent No. 4. Mr. B.K. Prasad, Advocate has on 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2015 filed Vakalatnama/Appearance on behalf of Respondent Nos. 1 to 3, 5 and 6 and on 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2015 filed Counter Affidavit on their behalf. Copies of the counter affidavit have been included in the paper books.

It is submitted that the office report was listed before Ld. Registrar's Court from time to time and lastly listed on 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2016, when the following order was passed:-

**“Respondent nos. 1 to 3, 5 and 6 have already filed counter affidavit.**

**Respondent no. 4 has not filed counter affidavit despite last opportunity having been granted. As such, further opportunity is declined.**

**Registry to process the matter for being listed before the Hon'ble Court as per rules.”**

It is further submitted that counsel for Respondent No.4 has not filed counter affidavit so far.

It is lastly submitted that the matter was listed before the Hon'ble Court on 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2016, when the Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

**“Heard.**

**Counter affidavit has been filed on behalf of Union of India and other respondents except the State of Gujarat. Ms. Hemantika Wahi, learned counsel for the respondent-state, submits that she does not propose to file any counter affidavit. Learned counsel for the petitioner also does not propose to file any rejoinder affidavit. They submit that connected matters are coming up for hearing on 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2016 before another Bench involving similar question of law.**

SLP(C) NO. 7208 OF 2016
