This is wife's petition seeking transfer of case being F.C.O.P. No. 1388 of 2012 titled "Satheish Babu Vs. Sheeba" from the First Additional Family Court, Chennai, Tamil Nadu to the Family Court, Kannur, Kerala.

Sheeba" from the First Additional Family Court, Chennai, Tamil Nadu to the Principal Judge, Family Court, Kannur, Kerala. The transferrer court shall transmit the record and proceedings of the transferred case to the transferee court without any delay.
- The transferee court is requested to hear and decide the transferred case as expeditiously as may be possible. The parties are directed to co-operate with the transferee court in expeditious disposal of the transferred case.
- The transferee court may explore the possibility of settlement between the parties through the process of mediation.
