A W A R D

General Insurance Company Ltd. submit that the Insurance Company is prepared to pay a further sum of Rupees Four Lakhs as full and final compensation to the petitioner(s) (claimant(s)), over and above what has been awarded by the High Court. This additional sum is acceptable to the claimant(s) as submitted by Mrs. Supreeta Patil, learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the matter stands disposed of by directing the respondent - Insurance Company to deposit the additional sum of Rupees Four Lakhs with the MACT, Ballari within four weeks from today. Thereafter, the deposited sum be released to the petitioner(s) (claimant(s)) by the Tribunal.

4. The matter stands disposed of in terms of the award.
