In view of the aforesaid, we take modified settlement on record and the parties will remain bound by the modified settlement with the possession being jointly handed over to all the five parties by the Receiver, who will thereafter carry out the settlement. In terms thereof, the property has to be sold to a third party with proceeds divided, instead of the earlier settlement and the amount which was taken from Smt. Sunita Jain is to be returned to her who would be directly paid by the prospective purchaser.

MA also stands disposed of.

Needless to say that on application being made for conversion of lease hold to free hold, the Land and Development office (LNDO) will process not application expeditiously and later
