O R D E R

The office report dated March 29, 2011 states  
that the learned counsel for the petitioners has  
not paid process fee of Rs.10/- with one spare copy  
of special leave petition within the period of one  
week for issue of fresh notice upon unserved  
respondent No. 2.            However, the learned counsel for

the petitioners states that process fee was paid

The office report further mentions that in

petitioner has not filed affidavit with proof of dasti service in respect of respondent Nos. 3 to 5 but the learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has filed an affidavit on March 7, 2011 with proof of dasti service in respect of respondent Nos. 3 and 4 stating therein that respondent No. 3 has been served with the notice whereas respondent No. 4 is reported to be dead. Further as per the office report, the learned counsel for the petitioners has not filed affidavit with proof of dasti in respect of respondent No. 5 and has also not taken steps to bring on record the Lrs of deceased Respondent No. 4 so far. The learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to take appropriate steps to remove the defects, as mentioned in the office report, within four weeks from today failing which the SLP(C) No. 35223/2010 shall stand dismissed for default.
