UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following ORDER

The office report indicates that the counter affidavit filed by the learned counsel for the respondent No.1 is defective. Dasti in addition is permitted to be served through the District Court the particulars of which shall be furnished by the learned counsel for the petitioner within the period prescribed above.
