O R D E R

Arising out of an order dated 02.08.2022 in **Supriya Vinayak Gawande vs. State of Maharashtra & Ors. (Writ Petition No. 5294 of 2019)** along with other matters passed by the High Court, Special Leave Petition (C) No. 14803/2022 was dismissed by the co-

ordinate Bench on 06.09.2022.
