 O R D E R**

1. Delay condoned.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although there are concurrent findings of three courts to the effect that the petitioner is guilty of the offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, he submits that an opportunity for having the matter settled may be given.
3. The petitioner shall deposit Rs.4,00,000/- (four lakh) with the Registry of this Court within four weeks.
4. Subject to such deposit, notice be issued to the respondent.
5. In the event the deposit is not made, the special leave petition shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Court.

6. The benefit of exemption from surrendering, already granted by the earlier order, shall continue subject to deposit as above.
