Having heard learned counsel for the appellant on the question of stay with regard to the arrears of service tax as on 30th ..2/-

: 2 :

September, 2011, we direct that subject to appellant's clearing all the arrears payable as on the said date in three equated instalments, payable on or before 15th March, 2012; 15th May, 2012 and 15th July, 2012, no coercive steps shall be taken against the appellant for the recovery of the said arrears. However, in the event of default on the part of the appellant in deposit of any one of the instalments by the due date, it will be open to the respondents to recover the entire amount in arrears forthwith.

We clarify that there is no stay of imposition of service tax under sub-clause (zzzz) of clause (105) of Section 65 read with Section 66 of the Finance Act, 1994 (as amended), insofar as the future liability towards service tax with effect from 1st October, 2011 is concerned.
