**OFFICE REPORT**

The matters above mentioned were listed before the Ld. Registrar's Court on 13th May, 2015 when inter-alia the following order was passed:-

**"C.A.No.2481/2010**

Among 15 respondents,  
service of respondent nos. 1 to 6,  
8 to 10 and 12 to 14 is complete  
but none has entered appearance.

Vakalatnama on behalf of  
respondent Nos. 7,11 and 15 has  
already been filed.

**C.A.No.2482/2010**

Among ten respondents,  
presence of all the ten  
respondents is complete but  
none has entered appearance.

**C.A.No.2483/2010**

Among 13 respondents herein,  
respondent nos. 3,6,9,10 and 13  
have failed to enter appearance  
despite service.

Respondent  
Nos.1,2,4,5,7,8,11 and 12 being  
common to other appeals, have  
also failed to appear despite  
being duly served.

**C.A.No.2484/2010**

Service with respect to  
respondent Nos. 6,8,10,15 and  
16 among 16 respondents is  
still not complete.

Appellant has to take  
appropriate fresh steps for the  
same.

Respondent Nos. 1 to 3,4,5,7,9 and 11 to 14 have failed to enter appearance despite service.  
List again on 21.8.2015."

**CIVIL APPEAL NO. 2481 OF 2010**

It is submitted that there are fifteen Respondents. Respondent Nos. 7 and 11 are represented by Mr. R. Nedumaran, Advocate. Respondent No. 15 is represented by Mr. Sureshan P., Advocate. Certificate of service has been received in respect of respondent Nos. 1 to 6, 8 to 10 and 12 to 14 respectively.

Service of notice is complete.

**CIVIL APPEAL NO. 2482 OF 2010**

It is submitted that there are ten Respondents. Respondent Nos. 1 to 3 are common and certificate of service has been received in respect of all the ten respondents.

**CIVIL APPEAL NO. 2483 OF 2010**

It is submitted that there are thirteen Respondents. Respondent Nos. 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, 8, 11 and 12 are common and certificate of service has been received in respect of respondent Nos. 3, 6, 9, 10 and 13.

Service of notice is complete.

**CIVIL APPEAL NO. 2484 OF 2010**

It is submitted that there are sixteen Respondents. Respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and 5 are common and certificate of service has been received in respect of respondent Nos. 4, 7, 9, 11 to 14. Certificate of service in respect of respondent Nos. 6, 8, 10, 15 and 16 has not been received so far.

Service of notice is incomplete.

Original record has been returned back to the High Court in terms of circular dated 4th December, 2014.

It is further submitted that counsel for the parties have not filed statement of cases and in terms of Order XIX Rule 32(2) Supreme Court Rules, 2013, and its proviso, where parties do not file statement of cases within the time prescribed, it shall be presumed that the parties do not desire to file statement of cases and they have adopted list of dates/synopsis as statement of cases.
