condition that the petitioners deposit Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten

Lac) with the Prescribed Authority within four weeks from today, without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the petitioners. On such deposit being made, the Prescribed Authority shall release a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lacs) in favour of the private respondent Nos.3 to 49 herein and the remaining amount shall be kept in a Fixed Deposit Account of a Nationalized Bank, initially

for a period of six months, which shall be renewed periodically,  
pending further orders to be passed by the High Court.

If the petitioners failed to comply with the condition now  
imposed, the benefit granted under this order will automatically  
cease to operate.
