Hence, the writ petitioner would be entitled to payment of full salary up to 19.8.1998 and we direct the appellant Corporation accordingly to pay the same expeditiously and not later than three months from the date of receipt of a copy of the order, failing which appellant Corporation shall liable pay interest @ 9% pendente lite."

The only stand of the petitioners was that the contesting private respondent was paid subsistence allowance from 01.05.1996 to 31.07.1998. If that be so, the compliance of the direct contained in paragraph 39 would be for the petitioners to pay the balance of the salary payable to the private 01.05.1996 to 19.08.1998.
