It is submitted for the information of the Hon'ble Court that there are twenty respondents in the instant matter. Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to all the respondents by registered A. D. post. M/s. Aura & Co., Advocates have filed vakalatnama/appearance on behalf of respondent No. 3 but they have not filed counter-affidavit so far. Ms. Bhargava V. Desai, Advocate has filed vakalatnama/appearance on behalf of respondent Nos. 5 to 20 but he has not filed counter-affidavit so far. A. D. cards duly signed have been received back from respondent Nos. 1 and 4 but no one has entered appearance so far. As per tracking report, unserved notice has been received back at New Delhi GPO in respect of respondent No. 2 with postal remarks "Delivery Attempted:Door Locked".

It is further submitted that Mr. P. J. Malkan, Advocate has filed an application for impleadment along-with vakalatnama/appearance which is registered as I. A. No 6 and the same is being circulated before the Hon'ble Court.

Service of notice is not complete on respondent No. 2.
