This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner - wife for transfer of O.S. No. 42 of 2017 titled "Lt. Col. Charanjeev Singh vs. Sandeep Kour" from the Court of Additional District Judge for Matrimonial Cases at Jammu to the Special Judge, Family Court, Dwarka, New Delhi.
