During course of submission, issues both on merits and on points of law have been raised by learned counsel for the revenue and respondent-Company. However, certain documents such as the alleged affidavit filed by the respondent-Company forgoing its actionable claim or entitlement are not part of the record. Moreover, the record also does not contain the documents collected during seizure which may have a bearing on the ultimate outcome on these issues i.e. whether the respondent-Company was liable to pay GST or not.
