- 1. Heard learned counsel for the applicants and learned A.G.A. for the State.
- 2. This application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the applicants to quash the summoning order dated 14.06.2023 passed by the judicial Magistrate, Sadar, Farrukhabad, in Complaint Case No.1580 of 2022, under Sections 323, 354, 452 I.P.C. against the applicant No.1 and for offence under Sections 452, 323 I.P.C. against the applicant Nos.2 to 6, P.S. Shamshabad, District Farrukhabad.
- 3. On the matter being taken up, learned counsel for the applicants have not pressed the relief as sought by means of this application on merit and prayed for issuance of appropriate direction to the concerned Courts below to decide the bail application of the applicants expeditiously.
- 4. Learned A.G.A. has no objection in allowing the aforesaid prayer of the applicants.
- 5. Accordingly the relief as sought by the applicants through this application is refused.
- 6. Considering the aforesaid alternative prayer of the applicants, it is directed that applicants shall surrender before the concerned Court below within three weeks from today and in case applies for bail, the bail application shall be decided expeditiously by the courts below in accordance with law laid down by the Apex Court in the case of **Satender Kumar Antil Vs. Central Bureau of Investigation** and another, reported in 2021 SCC OnLine SC 922.
- 7. For the period of three weeks from today or till the time of surrender of the applicants before the Court below, whichever is earlier, no coercive action shall be taken against them.
- 8. With the aforesaid directions, this application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. stands **disposed of.**
