Heard learned Counsel for petitioner and learned State Counsel for opposite party no. 1.

In view of the order being proposed to be passed, issuance of notice to opposite party no. 2 stands dispensed with.

Petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed seeking a direction to the court concerned for expeditious disposal of revision filed by the opposite party no. 2 under Section 219 of Land Revenue Act, 1901.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner is the respondent in the aforesaid revisional proceedings and has already filed objections, as such, directions are required for expeditious disposal of the revision.

Considering submissions advanced by learned Counsel for the petitioner, the opposite party no. 1 i.e., Learned Court of Board of Revenue, U.P., Lucknow, is directed to decide the revision filed by opposite party party no. 2 registered as Revision No. 155 of 2022 District- Ayodhya, (Smt. Shanti Devi versus Smt. Shakuntala and others) expeditiously, preferably within a period of six months from the date, a certified copy of this order is brought on record of proceedings, in case there is no other legal impediment.

Benefit of this order shall be available only in case petitioner cooperates in early conclusion of the application/trial.

With the aforesaid direction, the petition stands **disposed of**.
