Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner, Sri Yogesh Awasthi, learned State Counsel and perused the records.

In view of order proposed to be passed, issuance of notice to the private-respondent(s) is hereby dispensed with.

The present petition has been filed for the following main relief:-

"Issue an order or direction commanding opposite parties specially opposite party No. 1 i.e. Tehsildar Sadar, District Sultanpur to decide the revision case no. 2040/2023 (computer case no. C202304000002040) Bahadur Ali versus Shabina Parveen u/s 34 of U.P. Revenue Code 2006, pending in the court of opposite party no. 1 i.e. Tehsildar Sadar, District Sultanpur as early as possible within fixed time frame by this Hon'ble Court, under provisions of the sub rule 5 and 7 of Rule 34 of The Uttar Pradesh Revenue code Rules, 2016"

Considering the facts as stated, particularly the period of pendency of the revision, which appears to be pending since August 2022 as also taking note of statutory provisions including ***para 458(2) of U.P. Revenue Court Manual***, the present petition is disposed of with direction to opposite party no.1, to consider and decide the pending revision in issue i.e. Revision Case No. 2040/2023, computer case no. C202304000002040 (Bahadur Ali versus Shabina Parveen), most expeditiously, after affording full opportunity of hearing to the parties, but without granting any unnecessary adjournment, preferably within a period of six months from the next date fixed before it, if there is no other legal impediment in this regard.

It is made clear that the Court has not examined the case of either party on merits and the Authority concerned shall be free to decide the matter strictly in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid, the petition is ***disposed of***.
