The learned Counsel for the respondent has submitted that the first instalment of Rs.10 lakhs shall be paid by 31st January, 2023 and the second instalment by 15th March, 2023.

The parties are present before us. They have jointly submitted that some gold ornaments lying in the custody of Sri Saibal Chatterjee have been returned to the appellant, Smt. Sohini Chatterjee as per the list of ornaments annexed to the report filed by the learned Mediator. However, the locker at State Bank of India, New Ballygunj, Haltu Branch has not yet been opened in presence of the parties as agreed before the learned Mediator.

The matter shall be listed as "Part-Heard" on $27^{\rm th}$ March, 2023.

The parties shall in the meantime comply with the terms they have agreed before the learned Mediator and file their application for mutual divorce by the adjourned date.
