The writ petitioner complains that the private respondents are interfering with the possession of his land. After having grabbed 50% of the petitioner's share in the said property, the private respondents claim to have purchased the property in January 2022.

The demarcation or otherwise of the land and title between the petitioner and the private respondents and their mutual rights are purely civil disputes that must be agitated before a civil forum.

In that view of the matter, the Officer-in-Charge, Moynaguri Police Station shall ensure that there is absolutely no breach of peace in the area and shall continue to maintain strict vigil thereat.
