The petitioner was appointed as an Assistant Teacher of a High School and superannuated on 30.04.2018. The pension payment order was issued on 16.08.2018. subsequently, there was a revision of the pension and the gratuity amount payable to the petitioner under the ROPA, 2019 and the revised pension payment order was issued on 06.04.2021. The revised gratuity amount and arrear pension was disbursed in favour of the petitioner only on 04.05.2021. The petitioner claims interest on delayed payment of the revised gratuity amount.

Upon consideration of submission made on behalf of the parties and materials on record, the Director of Pension, Provident Fund and Group Insurance, Government of West Bengal and the Treasury Officer, Siliguri-II are directed to pay interest to the petitioner @ 8% per annum on the revised gratuity amount calculated from 14.02.2020 till the date of actual payment of the amount, since ROPA 2019 has been given effect from
